Depending on the ambient light situation, the projected image looks very different.

<u>Panasonic Solution</u>: Daylight View[™] Technology; images are altered to adjust for different ambient light situations.





Note: There are different versions of Daylight View.

If a projector has **System Daylight** View, this means that the projector does not have the ambient light sensor and the setting must be manually activated. Why? Projectors with System Daylight View are typically large venue projectors that will probably be installed in places that do not reflect the ambient light condition near the screen.

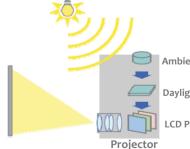
