
- Read this manual and the projector manual completely, and use this product correctly and safely.
- *All the projector illustrations in this manual are based on PT-DZ8700U and PT-DZ110XE model.
- **The full name of this product is [Replacement Filter Cartridge], and name [ACF unit] will be used when it is installed to the projector.

Before replacing the parts


- Turn off the main power of the projector and remove the power plug from the power socket when replacing the cartridge.
- Follow the procedures in the "Powering off the projector" section in the projector's Operating Instructions manual when turning off the projector.

■ Replacing the ACF unit.

(1) Loosen the [ACF unit cover screw] (one screw) until the screw turns freely in counterclockwise direction and remove the [ACF unit cover].



(2) Remove the [ACF unit] from the projector.



- After removing the [ACF unit], clean dust and other foreign objects from the vents of the ACF unit and the projector.
- (3) Insert the new [ACF unit] (the [replacement filter cartridge] of this product) into the projector firmly.
- (4) Secure the [ACF unit cover] with the [ACF unit cover screw] tightly.

(5) After the [ACF unit] is replaced, turn on the projector, select [REMAINING FILTER QUANTITY] in the [PROJECTOR SETUP] menu, select [OK] and then press <ENTER> button.




Attention:

- Please only use the projector with the ACF unit installed.
- · Please replace the ACF unit only with new and unused units.

Note:

- The projector will automatically shut down after 10 minutes if the ACF unit is not installed, as dust and foreign objects may get inside it and cause operating problems.
 - (The time of shutting down is shown in unit of 1 minute in the on-screen.)
- The time period to replace the ACF unit will depend on the operating environment.
- The winding up of the filter will start during reset.
 The <Filter Monitor> in front of the projector will blink in green during winding up.
 - The <Filter Monitor> will stop blinking when the winding up has finished. Sounds of the winding up action might be heard.
