


Remote Control Map



Quick Reference

This *Quick Reference* card gives brief instructions on connecting your projector and using common features. For details on setting up and using the projector, see the online *User's Guide*.

IMPORTANT: Before using this product, make sure you read these instructions and the safety instructions in the online *User's Guide*.



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Turning the Projector On

1. Turn on your computer or image source.
2. Press the **On** button on the remote control or projector. After the status light is solid blue, the projector is ready.


Note: If the Direct Power On function is enabled, you can turn the projector on without pressing the **On** button; just plug it in or flip the switch controlling the outlet to which the projector is connected. To turn on this feature, see the online *User's Guide*.

3. If your image does not appear, see “Switching Between Image Sources” or “Troubleshooting.”

Removing the Side Cover

To access the projector's control panel, focus lever, or connection ports, you need to remove the side cover.

1. Slide the lever to release the cover.
2. Pull the cover from the side of the projector.




Changing the Language of the Projector Menus

The default language of the projector's menu system is English, but you can change it as necessary.

1. Press the **Menu** button to access the projector's menu system.
2. Select **Management > Language**.
3. Select your language.
4. When you're done, press the **Menu** or **Esc** button to exit.

Switching Between Image Sources

Press one of the source buttons (remote control), or the **Source** button (projector).



Adjusting Image Position

1. Press the **Menu** button.
2. Select **Installation > Screen Position**.
3. Press the arrow buttons to adjust the position of the projected image.
4. When you're done, press the **Menu** or **Esc** button to finish the adjustment.

If the projector is on a table, you can level the image by turning any of the projector's adjustable feet.


Digital Zoom

1. Press the **Menu** button.
2. Select **Installation > Digital Zoom**.
3. Press the **Left** or **Right** arrow buttons to make the adjustment and press **Enter**.
4. Press the **Menu** or **Esc** button to exit the menu.

Using the Focus Lever

You can focus the image using the focus lever.

1. Remove the side cover. See “Removing the Side Cover.”
2. Move the focus lever in small increments to adjust the focus.



3. Replace the side cover.

Correcting Image Shape

If your image is uneven on the sides, you can use the projector's distortion correction features, such as Quick Corner®, Arc Correction, or Point Correction to adjust the shape. See the online *User's Guide*.

You can use the Epson Setting Assistant app to correct the shape of the projected image using the camera on your Android or iOS device.

Making Other Image Adjustments

For help on using the projector's features to improve the image quality, see the online *User's Guide*. You can also view information on how to adjust the image color, brightness, contrast, tint, saturation and dynamic range.

Turning the Projector Off

Press the **Standby** button on the remote control or the **Power** button on the projector to turn the projector off. If you see a confirmation message, press the **Standby** or **Power** button again.

Note: If the Direct Power On function is enabled, you can unplug the projector or flip the switch controlling the outlet to which the projector is connected instead. To turn on this feature, see the online *User's Guide*.

Troubleshooting

If you see a blank screen or the message **No signal**

- Make sure the status light on the projector is blue and not flashing.
- Press the **Blank** button on the remote control to see if the image was temporarily turned off.
- Make sure the cables are connected correctly. See the online *User's Guide*.
- You may need to change the image source. See “Switching Between Image Sources.” Also make sure the source device is turned on.

If the projector and the notebook don't display the same image

Windows®

Hold down the Windows key and press **P** at the same time, then click **Duplicate**.

Mac

On macOS 13.x or 14.x, select **System Settings > Displays**. Press the **+** pop-up menu button, then choose a display to mirror.

On macOS 12.x, select **System Preferences > Displays > Display Settings**. Select the projector, then choose the mirror option for your display from the drop-down menu.

On macOS 11.x and older, open **System Preferences** and select **Displays**. Click the **Arrangement** tab and select the **Mirror Displays** checkbox.
